

Sennheiser MKE400 Shotgun Kit

Additional Accessories



Use the MKH400 **shotgun microphone** instead of the built-in microphone when you need a higher-quality microphone with better off-axis rejection of unwanted sounds and/or need to place the mic in a location separate from the camera. Comes with **shoe adapter** for mounting on the Canon VIXIA or use the **pistol grip** for hand-holding. If you need to place the microphone in a position inconvenient to reach with the pistol-grip, the grip may be attached to the Rode **boom pole** (checked out separately). Use **foam wind screen** with the **windjammer** over it when conditions are windy.

Use the **lavaliere microphone** when you want to place the microphone on your subject, this is a convenient way to record dialogue. Use **foam wind screen** with the **lavaliere windjammer** over it when conditions are windy.

Use the **splitter cable** if you want to use two external microphones with the Canon VIXIA, the microphone connected to the black jack will be routed to channel 1 (left) and the microphone connected to the red jack will be on channel 2 (right) in the video clip.

Always monitor your audio recording using **headphones!** Remember to set the A/V Output settings to "Headphones" on the VIXIA camera, otherwise you'll hear unpleasant noises when you plug the headphones into the Canon VIXIA. See the camera handout for more information.
