

Canon Inkjet Printing Tutorial

⚠ Always open your project in *Photoshop*. Never print from *Preview* or a web browser.

1 Click **File** then **Print** in the dropdown menu.
This opens the "Photoshop Print Settings".

2 In the **Printer Setup** pane click **Printer:** to select either **S306 Inkjet 01 Luster** - OR - **S306 Inkjet 02 Matte**

3 Next click **Print Settings...** (you may need to click **Show Details**) to open the **Print** dialog and in **Paper Size:** select **Manage Custom Sizes...**

4 Click the plus sign "+" to add a custom size.

5 Rename the untitled size profile and set the **Paper Size Width** to **24** and then set the desired **Height**. Click **OK**

6 Click **Layout** and select **Quality & Media**

7 In **Media Type:** for **Luster** select **Photo Papers** and click **Canon PremiumSemi-GlossyPpr2 280** - OR - for **Matte** select **Coated Papers** and click **Heavyweight Coated Papers**

8 In **Print Quality** select **High** If your print is black and white check **Black and White Photo Print**

9 In the "Photoshop Print Settings" you will see a preview of your print based on your settings. You may need to select the proper orientation in **Layout:**

In the **Color Management** pane be sure that:
a **Color Handling:** **Printer Manages Color**
b **Normal Printing**
c **Rendering Intent:** **Perceptual** are all selected.

10 Scroll down to find the **Position and Size** pane. You can check **Scale to Fit Media** to automatically resize your project to the paper dimensions you've selected if desired.

Click **Print**

The **Paper Cut** login dialog will pop up. Enter your Net ID, password and a time limit then click **OK**
